Both New Democrat Candidates in Georgia Are a Grave Danger to the Safety of You and Your Family

Warnock and Ossoff Are Anti-safety Defund the Police Socialists

It has become almost a nightly ritual on the TV news — violent mobs of left-wing rioters flood our streets — smashing windows, looting stores, burning homes — terrorizing, assaulting, raping, and even murdering innocent and defenseless people, including unarmed women and senior citizens.

No wonder. You may recall Senator Kamala Harris — now Vice President-elect Kamala Harris — <u>stating this past summer</u> on *The Late Show with Stephen Colbert* her allegiance with these rioters:

"That's right. But they're not gonna stop.

They're not gonna stop, and this is a movement, I'm telling you.

They're not gonna stop, and everyone beware, because they're not gonna stop.

They're not gonna stop before Election Day in November, and they're not gonna stop after Election Day.

Everyone should take note of that, on both levels, that they're not going to let up -- and they should not.

And we should not."

Harris repeated some variation of "THEY'RE NOT GONNA STOP" about the violent riots *nine* times. Yet while the heavily-armed rioters — backed and cheered on by Harris — claim to be "protesting" for racial justice, their dangerous actions have left many black families with their homes and businesses destroyed, and their shattered communities in smoking ruins.

The only solution to such fierce and brutal savagery is a forceful crack-down by the police to restore law and order. But even as the violence spiraled out of control, one left-wing politician after another called on our communities to "defund the police" in defiance of common sense.

America at stake in Georgia Senate Runoff Election

Now control of our entire government comes down to two runoff elections for the U.S. Senate in Georgia on January 5th. Raphael Warnock and Jon Ossoff are the New Democrats'

candidates in each race, and both men are textbook examples of a left-wing politician calling to "defund the police."

Both men are on the same page with Kamala Harris, who ranted on the Stephen Colbert show in solidarity with these rioters. But maybe it was an unguarded moment of candor for Harris. Because her boss, President-Elect Joe Biden, has been a lot more guarded.

More recently, Biden <u>met with liberal civil rights leaders</u> in early December and told them that the ability of Republicans to define Democrats as being in favor of defunding the police is "how they beat the living hell out of us across the country."

Biden said his commitment to police reform was unwavering, but <u>he warned they should</u> <u>keep quiet</u> until after the runoff elections:

"I also don't think we should get too far ahead of ourselves on dealing with police reform in that, because they've already labeled us as being 'defund the police,' anything we put forward in terms of the organizational structure to change policing — which I promise you will occur, will occur. Promise you."

<u>Biden added</u>: "I just raise it with you to think about how much do we push between now and January 5th — we need those two seats — about police reform. But I guarantee you there will be a full-blown commission. I guarantee you it's a major, major, major element."

Warnock and Ossoff Stand for the Values of California and New York

And the two Georgia Democrats are not only in sync with Biden and Harris, but also House Speaker Nancy Pelosi of California and Senate Democrat Leader Chuck Schumer of New York. It's no coincidence that, since November 3rd, Ossoff and Warnock have <u>raised more money from California and New York</u> than from Georgia. Ossoff and Warnock don't stand for Georgia values, they stand for the anti-police, pro-rioter values of California and New York.

Make no mistake — the New Democrats' war on police is still very much alive — it's just holding its breath and keeping its mouth shut right now in hopes you won't notice it's still there. But the New Democrats' war on police will continue — just not openly until *after* the Georgia elections.

Top players leading the movement to defund the police have <u>declared their support</u> for Warnock and Ossoff. These radical left-wing groups include <u>Black Lives Matter</u>, the <u>Working Families Party</u>, a group of Hispanic activists called <u>Mijente</u>, and an African American group called Black to the Future.

The Working Families Party is <u>running phone banks</u> for Warnock from now through the runoff election. And Both Ossoff and Warnock are backed by Black Lives Matter PAC, which has <u>pledged to raise half-a-million dollars</u> for them.

What makes Warnock and Ossoff so dangerous is that they evidently don't know the difference between lawful behavior and criminal behavior. They call criminal acts "lawful," and they see lawful acts as "crimes."

For example, Ossoff said that Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents should be deployed to farms in Georgia — not to round up and deport illegal aliens — but to make sure any illegal aliens working there get good pay and have safe working conditions. No wonder Ossoff praised Pelosi's \$3 TRILLION "Heroes Act" bailout, which pays unemployment benefits to illegal aliens.

Ossoff campaigned with open borders politician Julián Castro, whose policies are so extreme that he's even been criticized by his fellow Democrats. But that's no problem for Jon Ossoff, who launched his own campaign describing himself as "Trump's worst nightmare."

Ossoff has also promised to legalize marijuana, decriminalize non-violent drug-related offenses, and establish more law-breaking sanctuary cities.

Warnock, meanwhile, <u>compared U.S. Senators to "gangsters and thugs"</u> after Congress passed President Trump's Tax Cuts and Jobs Act in 2017. He said: "...[T]here are more gangsters and thugs in Washington, D.C., in the Capitol than there are..." Warnock was unable to finish the sentence as his voice was drowned out by applause.

<u>Warnock worked</u> at the Abyssinian Baptist Church in Harlem in 1995 when the church invited Cuban dictator Fidel Castro to give a speech. And <u>Warnock has ties</u> to several radical black theologians, including Dr. James Hal Cone, who has called white Christians "satanic" and called for "the destruction of everything white." Warnock also <u>defended</u> Barack Obama's anti-Semitic pastor, Jeremiah Wright.

So it's no surprise <u>Warnock has compared</u> Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu to former segregationist governor George Wallace, and claimed that Israel was like apartheid South Africa and communist East Germany. Now that he's running for Senate, Warnock has tried to gloss over his apartheid comparison, claiming now that he is a "friend of Israel."

Warnock is noted for an <u>allegation of domestic violence</u>. Before their divorce was finalized, his ex-wife accused Warnock of running over her foot with a car during a heated argument. And Warnock was also briefly <u>charged in 2002</u> with obstructing a police investigation into suspected child abuse at a Maryland summer camp.

By their Silence, Warnock and Ossoff Encourage Rioters to Continue

Perhaps Warnock and Ossoff are calling to defund the police because they really don't understand what police are supposed to do, or maybe because they actually believe that police are bad and "criminals" are simply misunderstood. In any event, both men clearly have difficulty understanding the difference between things that are lawful and things that are criminal. That alone ought to disqualify either man from serving in the U.S. Senate.

But their hypocrisy on defunding the police may be an even worse offense. If Warnock and Ossoff really are against defunding the police, they should denounce the defund the police groups that have endorsed them and are raising money and making voter calls for their campaigns. To date, neither Warnock nor Ossoff has rejected these groups.

But it's not just the groups they've failed to condemn — it's the violence and lawlessness they promote that Warnock and Ossoff have failed to condemn. Neither man has condemned the violent riots that terrorize our cities, leaving our families to vulnerable and less safe in our own homes.

Most important, on a national level, the New Democrats see Warnock and Ossoff as the linchpins to the socialist transformation of America society. That's because, if they both win on January 5th, they will give the far-left socialist New Democrats a majority in Congress and a green light to begin putting their entire radical agenda into law.

But the downfall of our nation — and radical revolution — are exactly what they're after. Chuck Schumer said it himself: "Now we take Georgia, then we change America!" And farleft New York Representative Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez (AOC of "the Squad" infamy) doubled down: "We win these races in Georgia ... we don't have to negotiate."

That's what's at stake for you and your family's safety if the New Democrats win the Georgia runoff elections for the U.S. Senate on January 5th.
